



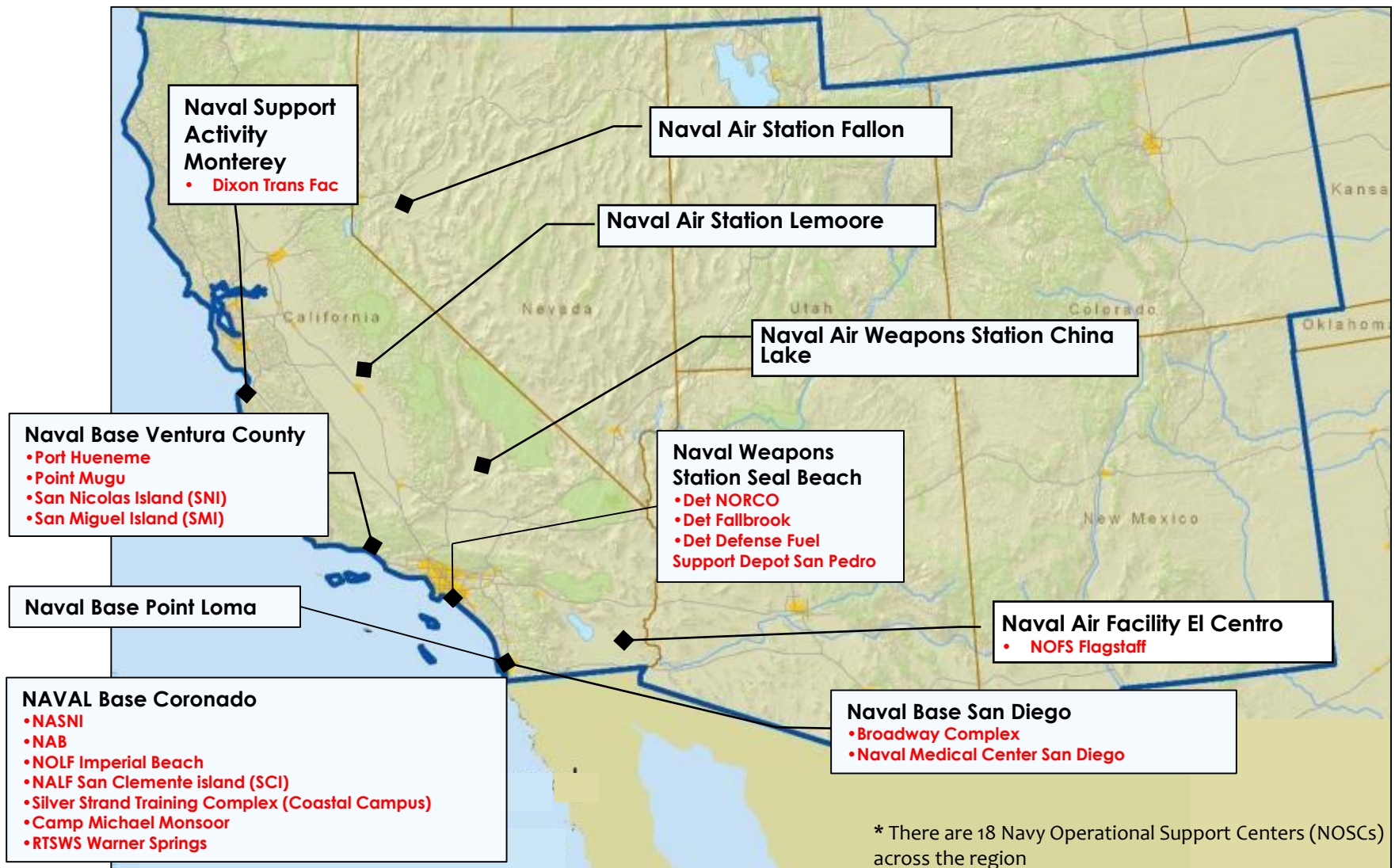

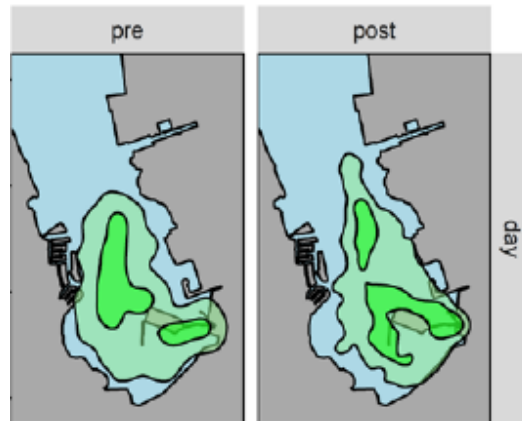

Highlights/Recent Accomplishments

- **Naval Base Ventura County:** Emerging leader in Salt Marsh Bird's-Beak management, CLT Fledges/Nest proportion all time high
- **Naval Weapons Station Seal Beach:** National Public Lands Day events to restore native vegetation along with USFWS refuge team
- **San Diego Bay:** Volunteer clean-up efforts removed >35-tons of trash (monofilament & scooters)

Lessons Learned/Shared

- **Coastal California** – Homelessness and Natural Resource impacts (**Monterey, San Pedro, San Diego**)
- **Fallon Range Training Complex** – Inadequacy is a feeling and an INRMP reality
- **Earthquake at China Lake** – Murphy's Law; One Good Deed Can Lead to Big Monetary Commitment – Mohave Tui Chub; Requirement Creep

How SW Supports the Mission: recent examples

- Burrowing owl translocation at Lemoore removes BASH risk.
- SCI species management program results in military training with minimal restrictions.
- Pt. Mugu avoidance and minimization measures meet needs for Sea Level Rise Retreat Plan to locate new facilities.
